Development for Supervisors.

Roche Mining invited Thrivability Training & Coaching to assist with devising a program to improve the technical quality of there open pit supervisors. This has been done and training starts the *last week of August 2005.* The program is based on the Metalliferous Training Package (MNM05) in particular the MNM40105 Certificate IV in Metalliferous Mining (Open Cut).

Other features include:

- Concentrates on technical development
- Ten days of training over 10 months
- Onsite assessment and coaching
- Blended to prepare participant for Restricted Quarry Managers examinations
- Seamless transition to Diploma level studies
- The four mandatory core units are generally undertaken by RPL
- The three general mandatory units (MNMG325A, MNMG326A and MNMG327A) are also available if required.

PS This program is also available to all interested contractor organisations and mining companies. Discussions on contextualising the program for metalliferous underground are also welcome.
