Upcoming Training

- **Open Pit Supervisor Training** - Mon 6th to Fri 10th February 2006. Five one day technical training courses for supervisors. (Certificate IV in Metalliferous Mining)
- **Quarry Manager Training** - 20th to 24nd February 2006. Five one day Metalliferous Mining Underpinning Knowledge training courses. (Diploma of Metalliferous Mining)
- **DOCEP Examination preparation course.** 28th Feb to 3rd Mar 2006. RQM, QM, U/G Supervisor and FCMM (mining law and practical).

Thrivability are rationalising its RTO offerings in 2006 and adding the Certificate IV in Training & Assessment. The TAA04 package is raising the bar for training providers and this is having a positive flow on effect to many other training packages.

In the New Year.



Thrivability Training & Coaching are introducing some **exciting new** training opportunities to Western Australia in 2006. Two that relate to risk are as follows:

- + Advanced risk management cluster – This is a five day course for Registered Mine Managers and Other Senior Mine Staff (Competency based learning [CBL] at Advanced Diploma level).
- + Train the Risk Facilitator – This is a three day skills development workshop for those with risk responsibilities or interests (CBL at Diploma level).

Other training clusters being offered include:

- + S1, S2, S3 cluster – Apply risk management processes, Conduct safety and health investigations, and Communicate information. This is a three day training program for Supervisors and Safety & Health Representatives. (CBL at Certificate III and IV levels).
- + Open Pit Supervisors cluster – This is a development program for open pit supervisors and involves two blocks of five days of training (CBL at Certificate IV level).
- + Underground Supervisors cluster – This is a development program for open pit supervisors and involves two blocks of five days of training (CBL at Certificate IV level).
- + Appointed Persons Training – s44 management appointments legislative training.
