Public Training Events June and July 2007

Diploma of Metalliferous Mining Mon 11th to Fri 15th June 2007

Five day training block will provide underpinning knowledge for six units from the Diploma of Metalliferous Mining (Compliance, Slopes Production/Transport, Services/infrastructure, Risk Management and Emergency Management.)

Train the Risk Facilitator Mon 25th to Wed 27th June 2006

The 3 day course involves three knowledge development sessions and seven skills development sessions. This course also clusters two nationally accredited diploma level units in facilitation.

Certificate IV in Occ Health & Safety Mon 9th to Wed 11th July 2007

Three day training block will provide underpinning knowledge (OHS Law, OHS Systems, and OHS consultation) and simulated experience.

RTO Developments

Thrivability Training and Coaching is now scoped in every state of Australia to deliver and assess the Certificate IV in OHS and the Diploma of OHS.

We have just completed development of all resource materials for the Certificate IV and Diploma of Project Management. We have a mining focus to our project management offering.

We are currently developing resource materials for two advanced diploma level units based on client request. They are: MNMMSM628A Establish ground control and slope stability systems. MNMMSM621A Establish mine water management system.

F2M to change name

The Business Services Training Package (BSB01) is to be replaced by BSB07 later this year. The main change of importance to mining people is that Diploma of Business (Frontline Management) will be replaced by Diploma of Management. The current Certificate IV in Business (Frontline Management) will be replaced by Certificate IV in Frontline Management. So essentially they are removing the business name from these offerings.

Thrivability Update

We have started offering selected units from the Advanced Diploma of Metalliferous Mining. The first two to be used are the what we call the "risk cluster" and are designed for Mine Management: They are: MNMMSM617A Establish the risk management system. MNMMSM624A Establish and manage the mine occupational health and safety management system. In the last course participants developed an integrated risk management system.
