Since the last newsletter Thrivability have been busy developing training resources for the Diploma of Occupational Health and Safety (BSBOHS)

The following units have been developed:

- BSBOHS501A Participate in the coordination and maintenance of a systematic approach to managing OHS
- BSBOHS502A Participate in the management of the OHS information and data systems
- BSBOHS503A Assist in the design and development of OHS participative arrangements
- BSBOHS504A Apply principles of OHS risk management
- BSBOHS505A Manage hazards in the work environment
- BSBOHS506A Monitor and facilitate the management of hazards associated with plant
- BSBOHS507A Facilitate the application of principles of occupational health to control OHS risk
- BSBOHS508A Participate in the investigation of incidents

Cover Story In the new year...

Thrivability Training & Coaching are introducing some exciting new training opportunities to Western Australia in 2007. They include:

- Certificate IV in Occupational Health & Safety This will involve 4+3 days of training and is designed for OHS practitioners in the mining industry.
- Diploma of Project Management This will involve 5+4 days of training and is designed for people managing projects in the mining industry.

Other training being offered include:

- Advanced risk management cluster This is a five day course for Registered Mine Managers and Other Senior Mine Staff (Competency based learning [CBL] at Advanced Diploma level).
- Train the Risk Facilitator This is a three day skills development workshop for those with risk responsibilities or interests (CBL at Diploma level).
- S1, S2, S3 cluster Apply risk management processes, Conduct safety and health investigations, and Communicate information. This is a three day training program for Supervisors and Safety & Health Representatives. (CBL at Certificate III and IV levels).
- Open Pit Supervisors cluster This is a development program for open pit supervisors (CBL at Certificate IV level).
- Appointed Persons Training s44 management appointments legislative training (Only delivered in-house).
