- 1,212 Appointed Persons were trained and bring the total number to 3,769
- A Generic s44 Appointed Person program was devised and delivered
- TNLC Blasting Geomechanics run a successful International Blasting Geology Workshop in Melbourne (43 attendees)
- Five technical blasting papers (one a Keynote address) were published and presented at two international conferences (New Zealand and Portugal) and at Explo 2011 in Melbourne.
- Demand for Risk facilitation and Blast consulting work was strong.
