It is also available for private delivery on-site. The training program involves undertaking 13 units of competency. Note completion of this qualification provides direct entry into the Diploma of Surface Operations Management which can lead on the ability to obtain a WA Quarry Managers certificate of competency.

**Who should enrol?** Supervisors and step-up positions with less than 3 years supervisory experience. More experienced supervisors can also be directed to this program by their employer if they see benefits.
